I moved to Orangeburg then Columbia, SC. in 2000. In 2008 I ended up at the Samaritan House Shelter while awaiting trial for Disability which didn't happen until March 2010; thus I moved to Columbia in May 2010 and earned my Associates at Midlands Tech. I left to get my Bachelors at Clayton State in Morrow Ga, May 2013 but moved back to Columbia, at Crossroads Apt. Feb. 11th 2015.

From April 2010 through now I've been totally disabled and going to college and when I moved back Feb. 2015 to South Carolina found out I was eligible to get my student loans discharge cause I am disabled.

My problem: ① ^{my} doctors won't sign the application downloaded from Nelnet Loan Discharge and ② The only other way to get discharge is by a Qvery Benefit Statement from Social Security but on Page 3 where

It states "Next medical review must be 5 yrs
mine said 3 yrs → but March 2016 I get inter-
view medically so I am being charged \$253
monthly. ~~Denied~~ by NCDOT. I cannot pay
that \$253 because ① CrossRoads apts
raised my rent up to \$593, my car payment
is \$382 with insurance \$102 thus I am barely
making ends meet. I will end up in a
shelter or on the street soon. I've written
to HUD, South Carolina State Housing, Water
because I am getting behind on lights \$255
and there's no place online because the water
action agency list is outdated and many of the
links are not working. I know other people who are
disabled and pay \$150 for rent, where can I
get help as a 58 yr old disabled person on
controlled meds so I went bse everything again
and end up homeless? I've written to certain

agencies like AHeP, housing for elderly or disabled
and either I have to wait till I'm 62 (I am
58) or the program is shut down see now.
I've worked hard most my life as a work-a-holic
and now its like because I'm hurt there is no
place to help me. I'm getting a decent amount
on my once a month disability, etc but as I
said with medical doctor bills, medicine, 2012 care
payment, high rent which goes up \$100 every year
where I am then with basic living costs like food,
gas to doctors, laundry. I am struggling and
need help. I know your office know what
agencies are funded to help me get out of the
hole, get an income-based place to live so I can
continue to be a productive tax paying citizen
not as a homeless person, female.
