On Wednesday, the General Assembly passed House Bill 3266, the Trespasser Responsibility Act. This legislation protects property owners from lawsuits by unwanted trespassers. Essentially, the bill codifies the common law for trespassing.

The South Carolina Forestry Association strongly advocated for the passage of H. 3266 and respectfully requests that Governor Haley sign the bill into law.

Several other organizations supported the bill including the SC Civil Justice Coalition, SC Chamber of Commerce, SC Farm Bureau, and the Palmetto Agribusiness Council.
