

November 28, 1944.

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's Office at 10:30 on November 28, 1944. All members of the Commission were present.

The Commission considered the request of the various departments and institutions for appropriations for the fiscal year 1945-46, and instructed the Secretary to follow certain policies conducted by the Commission in preparing tentative drafts of the budget for further consideration of the Budget Commission; and to schedule meetings of the Commission as soon as possible to consider these tentative drafts.

All of the above transfers within Item 1 of the Section.

The Commission allotted \$2,000.00 to the South Carolina Magazine,
to assist in defraying the expenses of a special edition to be largely devoted
