My name is Nina Mullikin. I am the Maternal Grandmother of Lindan RIVER Mullikin who is currently placed in the custody of DSS & Child Protective Services of Richland County, S.C. He has been there 3 months now at age 2 years old.

This letter represents a plea from any and all of those addressed above, for intervention and investigation into the " actions , lack of action, & inappropriate actions " by the Richland County DSS & Child Protective Services. I have passionately pursued the return of my grandson River to Family by contacting the the Caseworker, the Foster Care Case Worker, The DSS Constituency Office, The Richland County DSS Director, and many others on a consistent basis. My phone calls are not returned or forwarded to another Department , my questions and concerns not answered or addressed.

I submitted my " Home Study " packet over two months ago . River's Guardian ad Litem (GAL) had expressed her findings that River be sent home to me. On the May 26th court date Ms Cheryl Dorsey, the Case worker in charge , provided false, unfounded allegations against me swaying the opinion of River's (GAL), Delaney Morgan , her Attorney Betsy Burton , Foster Care Case Worker Caretta Bush, and the DSS Attorney. Even with the highly slanderous allegations lodged against me by Ms Dorsey, the Judge still ruled he wanted the case EXPEDITED and a Home Study performed on Me. The Home Study was performed July 5th, 40 DAYS after the Judge's ruling . It will be two weeks tomorrow since the Home Study was performed and though I have called and texted and sent messages via co-workers to Ms Caretta Bush , I have recieved no response. TO BE NOTED ; River's (GAL) , Delayne Morgan performed further investigation into Ms Dorsey's accusations and found them to be untrue and is AGAIN expressing to the Judge that my grandson come home to me on the scheduled July 28th Court date.

During the Home Inspection I was informed by Ms Bush that they had located the Child's Father , John T. Littrell, and he had consented to a DNA test , " nothing had come back on his record in Lexington County S.C. and his Probation Officer had voiced he had no problem with Mr. Littrell gaining custody of River." River does not know his father & has no relationship with him whatsoever . Mr. Littrell has made no attempt to involve himself in his son's life and has avoided paying any child support . I am attaching lengthy Lexington County incident reports regarding Mr. Littrells criminal history as recent as 6 months ago and will forward more when received from the Lexington County Clerk of Court . I am incensed that DSS/ Child Protective Services would even remotely consider this individual as a caretaker for My grandson or any


other child and have him remain in Foster Care when he could have been with his Grandmother with whom he has known since birth 2 months ago .

Allison Grant contacted the Sheriff's Department on the morning of January 4, 2016. Grant stated after her boyfriend John Litrell's arrest for domestic violence the two reconciled and he moved back to their Wigmore Lane residence. Grant stated since this time due to his behavior she sometimes "stays with family and friends."

Grant stated Litrell does not have a key to the residence advising she filled each door lock with super glue and uses the remote garage door opener for entry to the home. Grant stated Litrell recently damaged property inside their home and then sat outside the residence waiting for her to come home.

Grant originally contacted the Sheriff's Department requesting a restraining order to keep him coming back to the residence. Grant was advised she would need to properly evict Litrell from the residence. Grant refused to contact the magistrate court stating "I am not waiting thirty days, I will just lie and say he does not live there."

Grant left the lobby.

I responded to this location in reference to a domestic assault.

The victim appeared emotionally distraught, fearful of the offender, and afraid to go to her residence while he was still there.

I determined household member relationship as intimate (boyfriend/girlfriend) with both parties cohabitating in the same residence.

5 factors for determining primary aggressor:

- 1) Prior complaints of domestic or family violence;
- 2) The relative severity of the injuries inflicted on each person, taking into account injuries alleged which may not be easily visible at the time of the investigation;
- 3) The likelihood of future injury to each person;
- 4) Whether one of the persons acted in self-defense;
- 5) Household member accounts regarding the history of domestic violence

On 09/09/2015 at approx 0007 hours, myself and Cpl Nicholson responded to the parking lot of 2373 Augusta Highway (CVS Pharmacy) in the Lexington area of Lexington County in reference to meeting a reported victim of a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival, I made contact with Alyson Grant who had her two small children with her. Alyson stated her and her boyfriend, John Littrell, had been in a verbal argument over how he spoke to her children when he grabbed her phone from her and physically assaulted her in her residence, located at 140 Wigmore Ln, Lexington, SC 29072. Alyson also showed injuries she sustained during the physical confrontation with John. Alyson's two children were a witness to the whole incident and the oldest clearly stated she saw what he was doing to her and asked him to stop. Alyson stated she had fear from further acts of violence from John and fear of being around him because of his violent manner.

Alyson stated that her, her two children and John were downstairs in the residence when he stated something to one of her children that she did not appreciate the manner and way he talked to her child. She stated they got in to an argument about it but then he went upstairs and she went in to the kitchen. She thought everything had been settled but then, without her knowing it, John had returned downstairs and in to the kitchen with her, snatching her phone out of her hand. He then proceeded to grab her by her arm and pull her to the stairs of the residence where he began to choke her with his forearm across her throat cutting off some circulation of air. When her children were told by her to go get help, John is reported to have told them "if you did you will get it". He was reported to have then grabbed her by her hair and pulled her up the stairs and in to the bedroom where he threw her on the bed and sat on top of her. While both downstairs before he pulled her upstairs and while he was sitting on her, Alyson stated John was striking her in the face, throat, and mouth area with a closed fist and pushing against her. When he was done and got off of her, her children had come upstairs and were sitting on the bed with her and John was reported to have been telling them he wasn't under any influence of drugs or alcohol and that he believed that they were ok so he followed her downstairs and when he thought everything was done, he was reported to have gone back upstairs to shower. Alyson stated that is when he took her children and fled the residence and met with law enforcement in the parking lot of the CVS Pharmacy. Alyson provided a written statement as to the details of the incident which identified John physically assaulting her in the presence of children as well as making a statement that could be taken as a threat toward one of her children. Alyson refused any EMS services and

further stated that John was supposed to already be on a No Contact Order from a previous domestic violence incident involving herself.

Alyson's two children, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were awake when law enforcement made contact with them and [REDACTED] adamantly stated she was telling John to stop hurting her mother.

When arrival was made to the residence, John was not able to be located but a truck matching the description of what he may be operating, a 2002 black Chevy Trailblazer, SC Tag KWM533, was seen at the entrance to the street of the residence and immediately upon identifying law enforcement at the residence, took off away from the residence, fleeing from law enforcement. A chase ensued which resulted in the vehicle eluding law enforcement temporarily and the vehicle was finally located, with the interior lights on and the driver side door partly opened, in the front of 157 Grafton Ln, Lexington, SC. Upon running the SC Tag through DMV database, John Littrell, the boyfriend who was being sought for the incident, was identified as the registered owner. Sgt Wiseman had arrived on scene to assist with the incident and John was not able to be located in the vicinity of the vehicle and a consent to search of the house where it was parked by the resident owner was obtained which met with negative results. A K9 track was then initiated which resulted in finding John behind bushes that were in the backyard of residence 136 Wingmore Ln, Lexington, SC. John was instructed to come out of the bushes and immediately go to the ground, which he complied with. Once he was on the ground, he was informed he was being arrested for Domestic violence and due to his build and muscular development, two pairs of handcuffs had to be utilized in order to secure his hands. He was searched on the right side of his body and when proceeding to the back area to include his waist band of the shorts he was wearing, he had maintained his arms against his back. When his arms were raised in order to search the waist band area, he jerked his body and twisted away from my grasp attempting to free himself from law enforcement control, which resulted in him being placed on to the ground and informed to not provide any means of resistance. Once he was picked up, he was walked over to Cpl Nicholson's patrol vehicle and placed inside. At this point of the arrest, Deputy Dubard had arrived and once inside the patrol vehicle, he became combative and refusing to comply with instructions given to him by law enforcement personnel. He refused to remain seated in the area behind the front passenger seat, rather he was sliding himself in a manner to not be secured properly in the vehicle toward to opposite side of the vehicle. He also utilized his right leg to kick the door as it was being closed, thus causing the door to remain open. He also would not sit back in the seat so as to allow for the seat belt to be placed properly over him to secure him safely for the transport to the LCDC. Open handed control techniques were utilized in order to maintain control over him and prevent him from utilizing his body in a manner that would reflect aggressive resistance as he had already displayed. A hobble restraint device was utilized in order to maintain control over his legs so as to not allow him to utilize them in an aggressive manner as he had already demonstrated. He also was observed striking his head on the glass of the door several times and was informed to calm down numerous times by law enforcement personnel, which resulted in him going from crying to anger moods throughout the remainder of law enforcement's interaction with him.

During the close interactions with John, an odor of an unknown alcoholic type beverage was detected emanating from his person, although he claims to not have been consuming any alcoholic beverages as well

as any controlled substances. Throughout the interaction with John, he was argumentative, actively resisted efforts for a smooth and easy process of effecting an arrest, as well as used vulgarity toward law enforcement personnel and at one point, told Sgt Wiseman that he was a White Pessimist.

John was transported to the Lexington County Detention Center (LCDC) where he was booked and further processed with a bond hearing on 09/09/2015 at 1000 hours. John has two previous incidents of Domestic Violence charges within the past 5-10 years, but as of this incident no known convictions. Alyson was a previous victim to one of the previous incidents as well, as she stated. As he was being transported to the LCDC, he was reported to have stated to law enforcement that he was glad that he wasn't caught operating his vehicle while he was fleeing law enforcement as that would have been another DUI charge he may have received if caught driving.

Due to John's vehicle being parked in front of someone else's residence who did not want it there as well as no personnel available to take possession of his vehicle, John's vehicle was towed by Wingard's Towing to their private lot. An inventory was conducted and upon completion, the doors were secured and no items were removed from the vehicle.

Pictures were taken of the injuries sustained to Alyson and she was provided a case number as well as a Advisement of Protection form.

On August 28, 2015 I responded to 140 Wigmore Ln. in Lexington S.C located in Lexington County in reference to a Domestic Problem. Upon arrival I made contact with the caller Alyson Grant, who stated that her boyfriend John Lattrell of which she has lived with for more than a year, got into a verbal dispute, in which she told him to leave the home and he refused.

Alyson went on to say that at approximately 1000 hours on August 28, 2015 she had asked John to leave because he had began to drink alcohol and she knew when he got drunk he would begin to act different. She stated that John originally argued with her about his drinking and him having to leave the house. Alyson stated she then told him that she was going to go outside and call the police. Alyson stated at this time John began to look for his keys to his Chevrolet Trailblazer so that he could leave the house as she had asked. I then asked why did she need to go outside to use the phone, she stated because inside the home she was unable to get good cell phone reception.

Alyson then stated approximately 45 minutes after John left he returned to the residence and attempted to make entry. She stated he went to the back door and attempted to get inside, then he came to the front door of the residence and looked inside the window, asking her to let him in. She stated she then called the police again and he left the scene for the second time.

While speaking to Alyson I observed a Black in color Chevrolet Trailblazer driving slowly past the residence. Alyson advised me that the vehicle passing the residence was in fact John's vehicle, the male half of this domestic dispute. I then got into my vehicle and attempted to make contact with John. When I pulled behind John in my patrol vehicle, I observed his vehicle go slightly to the right toward the curb but did not go off the road. I then initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle.

When I approached the vehicle I could smell an odor coming from the vehicle consistent with alcohol. I then made contact with the driver who identified himself as John Lattrell. I then asked John why was he driving slowly down the street, he stated he was attempting to make contact with Alyson but when he saw I was there he decided not to. I then asked John what had happened at the house located at 140 Wigmore Lane, he stated he and Alyson had got into an argument about him drinking, he stated then she asked him to leave and he left as soon as he found his keys. I then asked John had he been drinking, he stated that he had approximately 3-4 drinks within the past hour and a half. At this time I advised dispatch to send a SCHP unit to my location for a possible DUI. HP arrived on scene in approximately 20 minutes. I then turned John over to HP for DUI investigation.

I then re-established contact with Alyson. I then asked her had John attempted to assault her or threatened her during the reported incident, she stated he had not, she stated she only wanted him out because she was afraid that he would become violent and she had her [REDACTED] in the home at the time of the incident. I then asked did the argument take place in front of her [REDACTED], she stated she did not think so but the argument took place in multiple rooms in the house.

I then issued Alyson a case number card containing the case number for the report to be generated. I also issued Alyson an Advisement of Protection brochure. I also advised her of instructions as to how to gain a copy of the report. Nothing further to report.

On 2/28/2015 I was dispatched to 316 Ashmore Ln in the Lexington area of Lexington County in reference to an assault. Upon arrival, I met with Justin McDaniel who stated that his [REDACTED] had a bruise on [REDACTED] buttocks and he believed that [REDACTED] mother's boyfriend, John Latrell, caused it.

Justin stated that he gets [REDACTED] every weekend and last night when he was putting an overnight diaper on [REDACTED], he noticed a handprint-shaped bruise on [REDACTED] left buttock. Justin stated that when he asked [REDACTED] about it, [REDACTED] stated that John hit [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] didn't like John anymore.

Justin stated that he text messaged Alyson about the mark and asked her to ask John to not discipline their child. Justin advised Alyson replied that Justin would need to discuss that with John. Justin declined.

Justin provided me with a photograph of the bruise and I could see two fingers and a thumb. Justin then showed me [REDACTED] and the marking was there, but very faint.

I did not ask [REDACTED] any questions.

I then attempted to contact mom, Alyson Grant, with no contact. Justin was unable to provide an address for Alyson so I had LCC run her through DMV and found a possible address for her. Justin stated that the pick up and drop off is usually at his home and sometimes at his mother's home.

I called Sgt. Walters who called Sgt. Mefford of major crimes. I then contacted LCDSS because [REDACTED] is to be court ordered returned to Alyson on Sunday at 6PM. Alyson and John share a home.

DSS worker Charlene arrived on scene shortly after and began her interview of Justin. Justin advised that he did not report the mark sooner for fear that Alyson would keep [REDACTED] away from him since the court order is only every other weekend and he gets [REDACTED] more often than that. Charlene and I both photographed [REDACTED] together. I obtained a statement from Justin.

DSS worker Charlene and I went to the home listed through DMV for Alyson. Alyson was home alone when we arrived. I did not ask any questions but did listen. Charlene asked if John ever applied corporal punishment to the kids and Alyson replied no although he does smack their hands if they "get into stuff".

Charlene then asked if she noticed the bruise on [REDACTED] and she advised yes. Alyson stated that she did not know where it came from but assumed it was when [REDACTED] fell down the stairs. Charlene advised Alyson that it was a clear handprint and Alyson advised that she did not know why. Charlene then asked if John knew about the handprint and she stated yes but denied knowing how it happened.

I then left the interview to handle another call.

I made contact with Charlene again who advised that she made a safety plan that stated that John is not to be alone with [REDACTED] and that no physical punishment should be given.

I provided Justin the case number for his records.

I responded to this location in reference to a domestic assault.

The victim appeared crying and extremely emotional.

I determined household member relationship as cohabitate intimately together as girlfriend and boyfriend.

5 factors for determining primary aggressor:

- 1) Prior complaints of domestic or family violence; None.
- 2) The relative severity of the injuries inflicted on each person, taking into account injuries alleged which may not be easily visible at the time of the investigation; Not severe
- 3) The likelihood of future injury to each person; likely
- 4) Whether one of the persons acted in self-defense; None.
- 5) Household member accounts regarding the history of domestic violence

On 11/27/2014 at approximately 0200 hours, M/D Ward and I responded to 140 Wigmore Ln. in reference to a domestic dispute. Upon arriving on scene, I observed a white 4-door Volkswagen Jetta, bearing SC Tag#JXW311, parked in front of the residence and paralleling the curb, with the lights on. This vehicle matched the description of a "white 4-door vehicle" that had described by the victim, Alyson Grant, while she was speaking with LCCC. I observed the vehicle then pull away from the residence and proceed down Wigmore Ln. toward the exit of the subdivision. I then proceeded to follow the vehicle, which turned right on Olde Farm Rd. toward Augusta Hwy. I attempted to complete a traffic stop on the vehicle while driving on Olde Farm Rd. and the vehicle then turned back into the subdivision, coming to a stop after re-entering the driveway of 140 Wigmore Ln. I observed who I then identified as, John Littrell, exit the vehicle wearing only a pair of basketball shorts and a hat. John began walking toward the front door of the residence and I verbally directed him to stop and speak with me about the incident. John then proceeded to run toward the front door and enter the residence stating, "You can't come in", and then attempted to shut and lock the door. I pursued John and upon entering the front door, I observed Alyson running up the stairs crying and John directly behind her repeating, "I didn't do anything, tell them I didn't do anything". I proceeded to verbally direct John to stop, which he did not, and I then grabbed him by the arm at the top of the stair case and stopped any further advances toward Alyson by immobilizing John against the wall and floor. M/D Ward entered the residence and aided in detaining John in handcuffs at that time, double locking them for safety. He was then walked outside the residence and placed into the back seat of M/D Ward's county vehicle.

I then re-entered the residence and spoke with Alyson about the incident. Alyson advised that John had been drinking tonight, approximately 10 shots of liquor, and they began a verbal altercation approximately 2 hours prior to calling 911. Alyson stated during that altercation, John had grabbed her around the lower jaw and neck area and "slammed me to the ground". Alyson stated she was able to leave the residence after the physical altercation and they began "texting" each other at that time. She returned to the residence approximately an hour to an hour and a half later and another verbal altercation ensued between them. Alyson stated she then went upstairs to the bedroom and locked the door while calling 911. John came upstairs and attempted to get into the bedroom only until he heard her on the phone with 911. Alyson stated that John then left at that time. A short while later John returned to the residence, Alyson still in the bedroom, and he began attempting to come into the room to get his wallet. Alyson stated that John then

"kicked the door in" and then left the residence again, which was just prior to our arrival on scene. I observed physical manifestation of injury on Alyson's left cheek in the form of a small scrape containing fresh wet blood, redness across her chest, under her lower jaw and neck area, and a small red scrape in the middle of her upper lip. Alyson advised that John had caused these injuries to her during the initial incident. I also observed the broken door frame to the upstairs bedroom, which was broken inward consistent to being kicked in, as well as 2 holes in the exterior side of the door and the metal latch laying in the hallway floor. Alyson also added that she was in fear of imminent peril during the incident.

While speaking with Alyson, she was constantly clearing her throat. EMS came to the residence to check for possible damage to her throat and neck area caused during the incident. EMS did not transport her.

I took photographs of Alyson's injury and damage to the door for evidence. I uploaded them into the evidence database. Alyson refused to provide a voluntary written statement.

M/D Ward advised that John would not speak with him about the incident and remained adamant that he had done nothing wrong.

Due to the physical manifestation of injury on Alyson, her being in fear of imminent peril due to John's actions in the physical assault as well as him damaging the door, I found John to be the primary aggressor and placed him into custody for CDV 2nd, due to LCCC running his CHR and advising that he had a prior CDV conviction within the past 10 years. John was searched incident to arrest. M/D Ward transported John to LCDC where he was booked. Warrant affidavit was sent to bond court.

I provided Alyson with an Advisement of Protection pamphlet and a case number. She advised she did wish to be present for John's bond court at 1000 hours, 11/27/2014.

Jessica advised the altercation began on their way back from Charlotte. Jessica advised they were arguing in their vehicle and John punched her in the left side of her face. Jessica advised John immediately apologized. Jessica advised when they returned home, another altercation arose because of how intoxicated John had become. Jessica advised they got into each other's face, John spit in her face and she spit in his. Jessica advised they soon began to argue over a hookah. Jessica advised she refused to allow John to use the hookah because of how intoxicated he was. She advised John flipped the table that the hookah was on, they shoved each other and then she ran into the bathroom to get away from him. Jessica advised John forced himself into the bathroom with her and punched her in the right side of her face three times. Jessica advised when she recovered, she followed John back into the living room and struck him in the face with a wooden sculpture. Jessica advised John then came from behind wrapping his arm around her throat, tightening his grip to where she couldn't breathe. Jessica advised John let her go when he realized she stopped struggling. Jessica advised when she caught her breath she told John she was calling the police and he fled the scene. I observed redness to Jessica's face. John was not on scene when I arrived. Photographs were taken of Jessica's face and she was provided with a victim right's form.

On March 28, 2012, at approximately 1:48 AM, I arrived in the vicinity of 1897 S Lake Dr in Lexington, SC. Deputy T Couch and MD Matt McCaw and I were dispatched to a possible Domestic related assault that had just occurred at the Shell - Corner Pantry located at the above address. Dispatch further informed us that the W/F left the scene driving a vehicle and that the W/M had gotten out of the vehicle reportedly bleeding and stating that he had been stabbed. The W/M, wearing shorts, had also fled the scene on foot, running north toward the Sonic Drive-in located next to the Corner Pantry. As I pulled into the parking lot of Sonic, I heard Deputy Couch state on the radio that he was out with a W/M subject fitting that description.

I then joined Deputy Couch and MD McCaw on the sidewalk north of Sonic. I observed Deputy Couch speaking with a W/Male - later identified as John Thomas Littrell. I observed that Littrell had, what appeared to be, blood on the left side of his leg. Deputy Couch detained Littrell and began speaking with him as to what happened. I then proceeded to the Corner Pantry to speak with the complainant - Nathan D Carroll, the clerk, and witness - Shawn C Hammer.

I first spoke with Hammer who stated that a female pulled up to the store driving a Buick 4 door vehicle. Hammer stated that a W/M was in the front passenger seat. Hammer stated that the female kept sounding the horn and telling the male to get out of the vehicle. Hammer stated that it appeared that the male "had her in a bear hug". Hammer stated that the male finally got out of the car and the female drove away south on Hwy 6. Hammer stated that he tried to ascertain what had taken place and the male told him that he had just been stabbed by the female and Hammer stated that he then noticed there was blood on the left leg of the male. Hammer stated that the male then began asking other customers for a ride and then, as he heard the sirens of the approaching patrol cars, fled the scene running behind Sonic.

I then spoke with Carroll who stated that he had heard someone sounding their car horn repeatedly and walked out of the store and observed a W/M who had a female "in a headlock" inside a vehicle and that the female kept "screaming at him to get out of the car". Carroll stated that he then called 911. Carroll stated that the male finally got out of the car and the female drove away and the male left the scene on foot. Both Carroll and Hammer described the car as a silver, gray, or beige Buick 4 door but were unable to obtain a tag number.

At that time I heard that MD McCaw had obtained the name and possible address of the female who had left the scene and was proceeding to 1103 Bluefield Rd in an effort to find her. While he proceeded to that address, I took a written statement from both Hammer and Carroll which is attached to this report.

Within approximately 10-15 minutes I heard on the radio that MD McCaw had located the female - Melissa R Knudstrup, at that location and was speaking with her. I then proceeded to 1103 Bluefield Rd where I spoke with Knudstrup who was already in the process of writing a statement. Knudstrup stated that around 7:00 PM Tuesday evening she was attending a wine tasting in the Five Points area of Columbia SC. Knudstrup stated that she had driven to that event alone but, shortly after arriving, had noticed Littrell also at the event. Knudstrup stated that she observed Littrell "ordering shots of liquor and getting verbally aggressive". Knudstrup then stated she slipped out to her car while Littrell was in the bathroom, hoping to leave, but that Littrell spotted her in the parking lot and ran up to her car and started "pounding on the windows". Knudstrup stated she then drove away and proceeded to Littrells house at 304 Luisa Ln in

Lexington to pick up her dogs and bring them to her parents house at 1103 Bluefield Rd where she would stay from time to time with her parents. Knudstrup stated that by the time she arrived at her parents house, Littrell was already there and was leaving the house with her father in her fathers truck to supposedly fix a flat tire on Littrells car. Knudstrup stated that Littrell then jumped out of her fathers truck and quickly got into her car. Littrell stated that she then told Littrell to get out of the car repeatedly but that he refused so she drove away from the residence with Littrell in the car. Knudstrup stated that while she was driving the vehicle, Littrell struck her in the mouth and on right side of her head with his fists. Knudstrup stated that she didn't know what else to do so she drove to the Corner Pantry and pulled in and started sounding her horn to draw someone's attention. Knudstrup stated that while Littrell had his arms wrapped around her head she kept screaming for him to get out of the car and tried to scare him with a corkscrew that she had in her vehicle. Knudstrup stated that she ended up hitting him in the leg with it because he wouldn't let go of her and get out of the vehicle. Knudstrup stated that she believed that the short blade on the corkscrew was half open when she struck Littrell with it. Knudstrup stated that when Littrell finally got out of her car, she drove back to her parents house where she was met MD McCaw a short while later.

I took a written statement from Knudstrup which is attached to this report. I also took photo's of Knudstrups face which appeared to be puffy with swelling around her right eye. I also observed that Knudstrups upper lip was bruised and swelling with a cut on the inside of her lip. I also observed bits of her hair on the side and back of her sweater that appeared to have been pulled out of her head. Knudstrup stated that she did not need EMS or any type of medical treatment. I also took photo's of the inside and outside of her vehicle. At that time I noticed the vehicles broken rear mirror laying on the floor of the front passenger side and a red smear, of what appeared to be dried blood, on the passenger side of the center console of the car. I also took into evidence the corkscrew which Knudstrup had struck Littrell with. Knudstrup's cell phone was also found to be in the possession of Littrell.

After speaking with MD McCaw and Deputy Couch, Littrell was placed under arrest for CDV-1st and transported by Deputy Couch to the LCDC to await a 9:00 AM Bond Court hearing. Knudstrup was provided with and signed as having received, a copy of the "Rights of Victims of Criminal Domestic Violence" information form which is also attached to this report. Knudstrup indicated that she did not wish to be present at Littrells Bond Hearing this morning.

I determined that Littrell and Knudstrup were living together at Littrells residence on and off as intimate boyfriend and girlfriend for approximately 1 year. (Knudstrup stated since 1/10/2011) While Littrell stated to Deputy Couch that he had cut his leg on some barbwire, the injury to his leg was consistent with what Knudstrup related to me. Given the physical manifestation of injuries on Knudstrup and the 2 eyewitness accounts of what they observed, I determined Littrell to be the primary aggressor.

Knudstrup was given this case number along with information on how to obtain a copy of this report. Littrell was advised by Deputy Couch of his upcoming court date and provided a copy of the UTT.
