Members of the House of Representatives,

We look forward to seeing you on Wednesday. Please see the attached veto messages for S. 293 and S. 813. We ask for your support and hope you will vote to sustain the Governor's vetoes.

1. R205, S.293, a bill that raises the cap on property taxes for the Murrell's Inlet-Garden City Fire District from 10 mills to 14 mills without a voter referendum. Local tax increases should first go to the citizens to be voted into law. Furthermore, we should not allow an appointed, unelected board the authority to set the new millage rate under the increased cap; and
2. R314, S.813, a bill expanding penalties for trespassing on certain public properties and granting library employees wide authority to deprive citizens of their ability to use public libraries for mere allegations of misconduct. Each county government can and should address these particular problems faced by public libraries in their community.
