Hi Mandy,

H. 3893 has been enrolled and will likely land on the Governor's desk next week. Among other things, it sets up a "special assessment panel" that will first meet within two weeks of the bill's signature and which must work with the Budget and Control Board to procure both (1) a "summative assessment system" and (2) a "college and career readiness assessment" by September 30, 2014.

The special assessment panel includes the Chairman of the South Carolina Technical College System Board or his designee. If it's a designee, that person has "to serve continuously instead of intermittently with himself or another designee." Assuming the bill is ratified next week and the Governor elects to sign it, the first meeting of this panel would likely be Monday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>.

I just wanted to give you a heads-up that this thing was out there, since the implementation timeline is fairly aggressive and we'll need to know who would be participating in relatively short order. I'll double-back early next week to discuss this a little more. Thanks.
