
Dear Senator Graham:

We noticed in today's Sun News that despite Gov. Haley's request to Secretary of State John Kerry not to place any Syrian refugees in South Carolina, because of concerns of inadequate security checks, the federal government is placing Syrian refugees here. We also learned that in response to a query from our governor the FBI Director, James Comey, specifically said, "We have no background on these refugees."

We strongly object to the granting of admission of these Syrian refugees into this country.
