EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

MRS. ELIZABETH BBAUFORD BESINGER, of Abbeville, S. C.

and

FURMAN BAGWELL, of Greenwood, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

JOHN DE LA HOWE SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 7th day of

July, A. D. 1960, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the McCormick Messenger, a newspaper published in the County of McCormick, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is JOHN DE LA HOWE SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is McCormick, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to promote acquaintance and fellowship among the members of this organization; to promote fellowship between the School and the Organization; and to promote Christian Education and the High Ideals for which the John De La Howe School was founded.

FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body public and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto.
