

Clinton and Spartanburg, South Carolina  
November 16, 1950

The State Budget and Control Board met at the State Training School in Clinton at 11:00 A. M. Messrs. Thurmond and Flowden, Board members, were present and also Mr. Verner. After a discussion of the Budget the group was shown over the Plant by the Superintendent. Lunch was provided at the Institution, after which the Board proceeded to Cedar Springs and to the School for the Deaf and Blind, arriving there at 3:00 P. M.
