Commissioner's Column

Today's Leaders at Boys State and Girls State---Tomorrow's Leaders of the State

What do Vice President Dick Cheney and broadcast journalist Jane Pauley have in common with South Carolina youth, Ben Setzler and Emily McCurry? They have all attended Boys State or Girls State.

A combined total of over a thousand boys and girls are selected each year by their teachers and counselors to attend Girls State and Boys State. The young people who attend these events are our future leaders. Many of South Carolina's political and business leaders were once delegates.

For the past 19 years, I have had the pleasure of hosting a reception for the officers of Palmetto Girls State, which is held each June at nearby Columbia College. Girls State is sponsored by the American Legion Auxiliary, the largest women's patriotic service organization in the nation. The Auxiliary believes that training our youth about the basic ideals and principles of our system of government will help to ensure the survival of our republic.

Emily McCurry, a rising senior at Belton-Honea Path High School, served as Commissioner of Agriculture for the 2002 Girls State. Her platform was based on the importance of supporting small family farms, the education of young children about agriculture, and protecting the environment through soil and water conservation. Too few people understand the importance of farmers and their families today. They not only work to provide the raw products for food, fiber, and shelter, but they are also environmentalists who protect the land on which they live and work.

Emily and her family live on a 60-acre farm. She serves as secretary of the Belton-Honea Path FFA. This past year, she and her fellow FFA members visited elementary schools, particularly the 3rd graders, to teach the smallest generation about agriculture and its importance. I commend Emily and her fellow FFA members as well as her FFA Adviser, Glenn Stevens, for their concerted effort.

In addition to the Auxiliary's Girls State, Boys State was founded by the American Legion to teach young men about government and politics. More specifically, the program is intended to spark interest and pride in government on a local level as well as the national scope.

The Palmetto Boys State has moved around the state since its inception in 1940. Originally housed at a school by the airport and later at the University of South Carolina in Columbia, Boys State was moved to The Citadel in Charleston in the late 1960s. From 1990 to 1998, Boys State was held at W offord College in Spartanburg and was returned to The Citadel in 1999 where it remains today.

Ben Setzler of Newberry served as this year's Commissioner of Agriculture for Boys State. Ben is a rising senior at Newberry High School. He said, "Boys State was a great experience! Wouldn't have missed it for the world!" He added that his grandfather passed the family farm to his father, Carl, and his uncle, Charles, who are identical twins. Ben along with his brother and his cousins, Charles' three sons, work on the farm, raising beef and turkeys.

Ben says that he hopes to attend Clemson University to major in something related to his love of agriculture. Since Newberry has no FFA program, Ben has been concentrating his efforts on becoming a member of the Newberry County Cattlemen's Association and the Bush River Young Farmers Association.

Educating our youth about the basic ideals and principles of our system of government will help to ensure the survival of our democracy. Citizenship and leadership are now more important than ever in the history of this state and nation. We must teach our youth to understand, comprehend, and appreciate their roles as citizens. And, we must teach them to stand united, especially during these trying times.

Upstate Goat Producers Field Day & Farm Life Expo

Don't let the sweltering summer get your goat! Learn first hand everything you ever wanted to know about goats and even more about farm life. Attend the Goat Producers Field Day & Farm Life Expo, scheduled from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, August 17, 2002, at Riverbend Equestrian Park, 173 Riverbend Rd., in Greenville.

A small meeting of goat producers in the upstate has blossomed into a full-blown field day and farm life expo because of a collaborative effort between the Upstate Goat Producers and other livestock producers as well as Clemson Extension Service and various ag organizations and agribusinesses.

Non-farming families as well as farm families are encouraged to attend the Field Day and Farm Life Expo. Education and fun are the primary goals for the day. To this end, the Upstate Goat Producers have tried to include something of interest for everyone from the seasoned producer to the smallest child.

Jerry Munns said, "Originally, this event served only the upstate goat producers. But, now, this has become a great family event for farmers and non-farmers. We want everyone to come and enjoy the day."

Participants will learn first-hand about goats including handspinning fiber, making goat milk soap and cheese. Barbecued goat meat, a tasty & healthy red meat, will be available for sale. The most current information will be available about the new Scrapie Program. Also, one lucky participant could be the proud owner of a goat. Proceeds from donations for the goat will go to the 4-H and FFA Wether Goat Project.

Other facets of farm life will also be on display including alpacas, llamas, emus, beekeeping, farm safety, arts and crafts, livestock guardian dogs, and herding dogs. Agribusiness representatives will be on hand to present the latest in farm services and supplies. Many demonstrations and educational seminars will be held throughout the day.

There will be both cooking and photography competitions for adults and youth. Event participants are encouraged to bring along a favorite goat meat or dairy dish as well as a copy of the recipe. Entries for the photography contest can depict any aspect of farm life.

Admission is free, and parking is ample in the 60-acre equestrian park. From Highway 25, Riverbend Equestrian Park is located at 173 Riverbend Rd. in Greenville.
