**WHEREAS,** our nation's veterans put their lives on the line to protect and preserve the American values of freedom and democracy; and

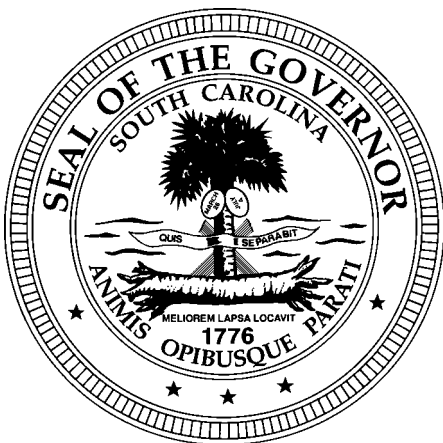
