M I N U T E S

Mr. Gilreath called the meeting to order and Councilman Lynch gave the invocation. Everyone stood and pledged allegiance to the flag.

On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the February 15, 16 & 19, 1983 meetings as mailed.

Ms. Dawn Hawkins representing the Haven of Rest, Salvation Army, GLEAAMS, and others, asked Council how the money designated for indigent citizens in Anderson County would be made available to these groups. She gave a brief report on the resources that DSS depend on when they have clients in need.

Ms. Susan Michelson announced the opening of a new health care program in Anderson County starting March 1, 1983, which will be called the Community Long Term Care System. She explained the program to the Council.

Mr. Doyle Kay, Director of the Anderson Oconee Alcohol & Drug Abuse Commission, asked Council to proclaim March as DUI MONTH in Anderson County. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Lynch, Council voted unanimously to declare March as DUI month.

Mr. Gilreath relinquished the chair to Mr. Lynch. Council took a short break. Mr. Lynch called the meeting back to order.

Mr. Gilreath presented Ordinance #109 calling for an appropriation of \$75,000 to provide an activity center and transportation for the senior citizens in Anderson County. On the motion of Mr. Gilreath, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted three in favor and two opposed. Mr. Rhodes and Mr. Lynch voted against the motion.

Mr. Watson presented second reading of Ordinance #107 which calls for an amendment to the 1982-83 fy budget which includes the proceeds from the sell of cattle at the stockade. On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted unanimously to approve on second reading.

Mr. Watson presented a request from Mr. Frank Floyd, Director of the Animal Shelter, to purchase two transceiver radios. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted unanimously to transfer \$1,000 from account #210 code 85 and \$500.00 from account #143 code 71 to account #143 code 85.

Mr. Watson announced the auction ~~that~~ will be held on Saturday, March 5, 1983 at 10:00 a.m.

On the motion of Mr. Gilreath, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to sell 25 additional cattle on Monday morning and to dispose of hogs as they become available.

Mr. Rhodes asked that the committee to clean up the Stockade be extended. The committee, Mr. Wiles and Mr. Rhodes, was extended as requested.

Mr. Wiles discussed a special training by the Anderson Fire Department dealing with hazardous materials. On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to allow the Fire Department to draw \$1,000 from their reserve fund.

Mr. James Hall gave a brief report on the County Fire Department.

Mr. Rhodes presented a proposal to increase the Delegation's salary by \$1606.70 for a total salary of \$13,098 effective 2-1-83 which will be a full time position, hours 9 to 5. The proposal was seconded by Mr. Wiles. Vote was unanimous. The \$1606.70 would be transferred from account number 210 code 84 into account 115 code 01.

Mr. Rhodes introduced a motion to pay Attorney Calhoun Pruitt for services rendered Anderson County regarding the change in the form of government. Money to come from the County Attorney's budget account #132 code 79. Motion was seconded by Mr. Lynch. Mr. Wiles amended the motion to transfer the money from account number 210 code 84. Motion was seconded by Mr. Rhodes. Vote was unanimous. Vote on the original motion was four in favor and 1 against. Mr. Alexander voted against the motion.

The County Attorney presented Ordinance #102 (Lakeshore Cable TV Franchise) for approval on second reading. On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted unanimously to approve the Ordinance on second reading.

Council discussed the Southern Railway bill. On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to pay the bill with the stipulation that the State be responsible for the liability clause and the money to come out of acct. #310.32.

Mr. Trey Senn read Ordinance #108 (Mobile Home Restrictions) for approval on first reading. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted unanimously to adopt on first reading.

Motion by Mr. Gilreath, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted 3 in favor to appoint Mr. Rhodes to the ANATS Committee. On the motion of Mr. Alexander, seconded by Mr. Gilreath, Council voted 3 in favor to appoint Mr. Wiles to the ANATS committee also. Mr. Wiles and Mr. Rhodes abstained from voting.

Council heard comments from various citizens. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted unanimously to buy keys for the news media for the press room.

On the motion of Mr. Alexander, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to go into executive session to discuss the hiring of the County Administrator at 11:30. Council adjourned at that time.
