### ***SNAP Recipients with Food Loss***

Many of you have asked us about Disaster SNAP (DSNAP). DSNAP has not been requested by the state, but there is an option to fill out an Affidavit of Loss Due to a Benefit Group Misfortune. If you have clients receiving SNAP who have lost food, they must fill out the following form and return it to their county office. Those affected only have 10 days from the loss to return the form.
