"The governor took a positive step today by vetoing the family planning section of the budget which sends your tax dollars to Planned Parenthood. However, your tax dollars still will flow to abortion providers through Medicaid coordinated care services. This veto does NOT fully defund Planned Parenthood and other abortion providers. My plan, as presented in Rep. McCravy's budget proviso, was the only precise remedy to fully defund abortion providers in our state. I wish the governor had held a press conference on that issue instead of leading from behind today and giving us half a loaf."
