I Mr Bethel were in the South Carolina Department of corrections serving a 5yr non violent sentences. I went up for Parole on August 26, 2015 and was granted Parole into the SPICE Program. on August 31, 2015 five days later I was shipped to Tyser^A Correctional Institution From Allendale to begin the SPICE Program. When an Inmate is shipped from one Institution to another, the sending Institution fills out an Inventory sheet indicating what items I have in my possession. on my Inventory sheet it was checked and listed that I have my bag of Medicine. When I first got here at Tyser River just walk through the door. The officer did an Inventory check on my bag from Allendale. When he set to my Medicine he Determined that my Medicine had expired he wrote me up for a "903" - The Trafficking Use and/or Possession of Narcotic, Marijuana or Unauthorized Drugs. Which that was not the case I had prescriptions for both of my Medicines both was taken as needed provided by the State and Medical approval and Inventory in ~~box~~ the institution. At that time I did not know that he was charging me with a 903 Drug charge I thought I

Pleading guilt to my own medication didn't think otherwise I tried to talk with the Captain, Major, warden and the Head People in Columbia even hire a lawyer because it was a major disciplinary causing me to be removed from the program and lose my parole. That's where I stand today they took my parole for my very own medications I had proof of everything my next step was to write you to see what you can do to help me. I never been in trouble in the Department of Corrections before and to get here and lose everything I work hard for nothing I did anything wrong to deserve this I have five kids just want to set out and do the right thing for them cannot supply for them like how I want to. That's why I tried my best to stay out of trouble to get back to them I came along way in life. I'm now studying in becoming a Young Minister to help kids around the world and community. That's my plan and goal. I suppose went home on Dec 17, 2015 but they took my parole back due to my first disciplinary for my own medication. Just thought the board could understand that, but they didn't. They already had taken my canteen, goodtime, custody level TV, phone calls, visitation, and had me on cell restricted. Just thought all that just was too much to lose my parole and remove from the program something that useful and help even the SPICE Coordinator didn't understand and thought it was going to be much of a big deal. I didn't have a write up since then I'm down to 10 months left or might be early if I get release on an early furlough. Know they can't stop that from Gov. I just don't think it's right and fair I didn't get into no fight or curse anyone or anything like that harmful to lose my parole. I just ask if
