Lexington Pond

James David Faulkenberry, five, the son of J. C. Faulkenberry of D-4 Gonzales Gardens, was drowned yesterday afternoon at George's pond, now known as Gibson's pond, in Lexington county. He was playing in the water with several other children when his playmates missed him.

The body was found shortly thereafter and artificial respiration was attempted, with Fire Chief A. McC. Marsh and Capt. R. B. Moore, Jr., and J. C. Johnson and G. W. Golin of the department seeking to save the child by means of a respirator.

The child is survived by his father; two sisters, Frances and Marie Faulkenberry; two brothers, Coxswain C. W. Faulkenberry with the United States Navy at Miami, Fla., and Coxswain J. C. Faulkenberry, Jr., in the Pacific and a number of aunts and uncles.

Funeral arrangements were incomplete this morning.
