Subject: Officers issuing tickets in violation of Executive Order

Richele,

Attached are two additional traffic tickets issued without regard to the Governor's Executive Order 2016-28 waving truck weight limits up to 90,000 pounds.

The first ticket was issued to Clay Scott W 498592 for hauling a load at vehicle weight of 88,000. This ticket clearly doesn't comply with the 90,000 pound allowance established under Executive Order 2016-28.

The second ticket issued to Ricky Smith W 498659 appears to be valid because Mr. Smith was hauling at a vehicle weight of 90,800 but the fine is calculated on a legal gross weight of 84,272 instead of 90,000 pounds.

I would appreciate you contacting the Department of Public Safety regarding these tickets.

Colonel Leroy Taylor did call me regarding the ticket issued in Fairfield County and said the case will be "not proessed". Colonel Taylor was very professional and indicated that a notice would be sent to his officers reminding them that Executive Order 2016-28 is still in effect. These tickets may have been written before he sent out that notice.
