

Per your November 20, 2009, request of information pursuant to the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act, we have provided the requested information, which is attached.

Additionally, you asked about the amount of money paid to Milliman during the contract period. To date we have paid Milliman \$1,452,342.38 for the May 1, 2008 -- June 30, 2009, contract period. This amount covers a host of actuarial services provided to the agency and is not exclusive to work on rehabilitative services.

Our expense, so far, for extracting and reproducing this information is eighty-five and no hundredths dollars (\$85.00). Please make the check payable to the Department of Health and Human Services and send it to:
