3. Objective(s):

- 5b. Continue to provide inclusive and accessible Mass Care and Medical Support operations while consolidating and eliminating shelters, and moving disaster survivors to a safe, sanitary and secure temporary housing solution.
10. Provide technical assistance and resources to address disaster survivor public and mental health needs.
- 3c. Provide accessible information to the whole community to assist in their recovery and to support response and recovery operations.
- 7a. Complete all Public and Individual Assistance Preliminary Damage Assessment, analysis and recommendation in all non-designated counties no later than 20 Oct 2015
- 6b. Provide accessible disaster recovery services to individuals, households and the private sector to include registration and case management.

- Coordinate feeding locations through the American Red Cross, The Salvation Army, DHEC and other partner volunteer organizations.
- Continue to coordinate the provision of ongoing outreach efforts to ensure all affected person have been identified and their emergency needs have been met.
- Coordinate Recovery support for counties that are beginning to transition to normal operating conditions.
- Coordinate the consolidation of shelters.

ESF-7 (Finance and Administration)

- Provide overall commodity and financial resource support for continuing operations.
- Process procurement needs for establishment of State portion of JFO.
- Coordinate specific support for recovery personnel requirements by EMAC and state Contracts.
- Establish financial operations for disaster federal funds.

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ESF-8 (Health and Medical Services)

- Coordinate services with Behavioral Health partners (i.e., VOAD, ARC, USC College of Social Work and various disability entities).
- Maintain situational awareness and coordinate support to MDRC/DRC locations.
- Coordinate and maintain situational awareness of temporary Tetanus vaccination sites and tetanus vaccination operations being conducted at all state health department locations.
- Provide Behavioral Health support at the DHEC tetanus clinics and coordinate with DMH to provide support to shelter operations and DRC locations.

ESF-13 (Law Enforcement)

- Coordinate law enforcement assistance to local law enforcement as requested.
- Coordinate support for damage assessment operations as requested.
- Provide communications support to local agencies as requested
- Provided public information/media support to local agencies as requested.

ESF-14 (Initial Recovery and Mitigation)

- Complete PA Assessments no later than 20 Oct in accordance with Schedule in order to add CAT C-G to the 7 Declared Counties to deliver programs to support infrastructure repair and reconstruction.
- Coordinate the submission of Request for Public Assistance for all State Agencies no later than 20 Oct in order to support reimbursable costs for CAT B under the Declaration.
- Complete State Agency Applicant Briefs no later than 23 Oct in order to deliver programs under the Declaration.
- Complete County Applicant Briefs for the 15 Declared PA Counties no later than 20 Oct in order to deliver programs under the Declaration.
- Complete Kick Off meetings w/in 21 Days of RPA submission by counties that are declared in order to support the Public Assistance project development to support repair and reconstruction.

General Situational Awareness:

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Weather

Record rainfall and subsequent riverine flooding significantly impacted South Carolina. The highest precipitation totals were recorded in a geographical area from Colleton County northward to Horry County and continuing back to the west in the Midlands and Pee Dee regions. Many areas saw rainfall amounts greater than 15 inches with locally heavier amounts measuring greater than 26 inches. The overall weather pattern also produced higher than normal tides, coastal flooding, beach erosion, gusty winds that downed trees, earthen dam failure, and river flooding. Cascading effects increased the overall impact in areas already inundated by rainfall.

A second round of widespread precipitation fell Saturday October 10. Locally heavier amounts were recorded in the same areas impacted earlier in the week. Flash flooding occurred in several counties, but did not significantly contribute to riverine flooding. The additional rainfall did cause issues for roadways, streams, and dams. Rainfall is not in the forecast for the next seven days.

As South Carolina moves into the recovery phase, there remains a river flooding and unexpected dam failure life safety hazard. The river flood threat is ending in the Midlands and shifting downstream toward coastal counties. The counties with the greatest potential impact for riverine flooding are forecasted for the Lowcountry and the Grand Strand. Rivers in the Upstate have gone down. The Midlands rivers are going down, but there is still some minor flooding. As for Lowcountry and northeastern South Carolina, the rivers have crested, and will take, in some cases, more than three to seven to days to get out of major and moderate flood. This situation presents long term safety concerns for those along the rivers in the northeastern portion of the state. Until the Waccamaw River recedes, Horry County will likely remain in the response phase through the end of the month.

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


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Projected River Forecast – 16 Oct 2015 (3 PM)
