Brief introduction

To further promote U.S.-China sub-national exchanges, the CPAFFC plans to hold the Fourth U.S.-China Governors Forum in Chengdu, Sichuan Province, on May 22 and 23, 2018. Themed on “China and the United States with Shared Future and Common Interest”, the forum will focus on promoting common development and prosperity of our two countries.

The U.S.-China Governors Forum is an important sub-national exchange mechanism between our two countries. Three forums and two round dialogues have been held in the U.S. and China since the Forum was launched in 2011. It provides a platform for governors of our two countries to share understanding, exchange views and generate pragmatic sub-national cooperation. In addition to the participation of governors and government officials, business and other sectors are also important part of the Forum.
