Mr. Duncan,

I am reaching out on the attached Advisory. SC has an HOS in place due to prior needs from the hurricane. Here is the background:

South Carolina is in a State of Emergency through the end of today by way of a prior Executive Order related to Hurricane Matthew. SC also waived the hours of service pursuant to the State of Emergency/Hurricane, which is good through tomorrow (Thursday). I don't think you are reporting this, but we also waived the weight restrictions, which in our state is good for 120 days (through February 1<sup>st</sup>) although we will probably end that sooner. Our HOS waive for 30 days, weight restrictions for 120 unless otherwise limited by the Order/subsequent Order.

We had already requested the FMCSA approve an additional back-to-back EO waiving hours of service under our current State of Emergency. Federal law requires approval for more than 30 days. Our plan is to issue that today assuming we receive approval. That would extend the HOS for an additional 30 days. I can update you when we receive that and issue the next EO. I have attached the current EO.
