The Commission approved a request from the State Hospital to increase the salary of its Business Manager from \$6,600.00 per year to \$7,260.00, effective February 16.

The Commission authorized the State Auditor to purchase two Remington Rand micro-filming machines to be assigned to State Departments as needed. 719

The Commission received a communication from the Hon. Tatum Gressette, Chairman of the Board of the State Industrial Schools, advising the Commission that because of certain unforeseen expenses at the Industrial School for Girls there would probably be an operating deficit for the current year amounting to about \$7,000.00 and requesting the Budget Commission to agree to supply this amount of money if and as the additional funds become necessary. The Commission instructed the State Auditor to advise the management of this Institution that it would agree to supply funds to cover unforeseen and emergency expenses only and would not underwrite a deficit not caused or contributed to by such emergencies.

The Commission then adjourned.
