The State Budget and Control Board met in the Governor's office at 3:30 P. M. on Monday, June 18, 1951. All members of the Board were present; and the meeting was also attended by Mr. Allen Lambright, Chairman of a House Committee to investigate the State Board of Health.

Dr. Ben F. Wyman appeared before the Board and, from a prepared statement, discussed the report of the State Auditor on the Organizational and Personnel Survey of the State Board of Health.

At the conclusion of the discussion, the State Auditor was directed to discuss the matter further with Dr. Wyman with the view of reconciling their views of the matter and to report back to the Board at its next meeting.
