Cardinal Luis Antonio Tagle **officially** launched the global pilgrimage portion of the **"Share the Journey" campaign** on Sunday.

Initiated by Pope Francis in September 2017, this campaign seeks to bridge the gap between communities and **migrants**.

As this initiative begins, thousands of migrants are literally journeying together towards Mexico, hoping to enter the United States. Bishop Joe Vásquez, Chairman of the **US Bishops' Conference Committee on Migration**, spoke with **Vatican News** about **the Church's response and how others can help**.

First priority: providing care

Bishop Vásquez said that the Church has issued statements regarding the "vast amount of people that are coming up from Honduras, traveling through Mexico", trying to reach the US border. He said that they have made it clear that **"the first priority is to take care of those people who are traveling."** Then he emphasized:

"The immigrant is so central to the Church . We're always speaking on behalf of the immigrant because they need protection, they need our help."

Groups assisting along the way

Bishop Vásquez confirmed that **various charitable organizations, Catholic** and non-Catholic, as well as people of good will, **are assisting the migrants on their journey north**.

"My understanding is that in different places along the way there are indeed Catholic organizations, Catholic groups that receive the migrants, allow them to stay overnight, give them food, give them assistance, make sure that they are protected."

He also acknowledged that most of the migrants leave with only the clothes on their backs and that the journey can at times be perilous. This is why **they need support from the Church** and the wider community.

What we can do

For those who wish to help, **Bishop Vásquez suggests contacting local Catholic Charities organizations or the local Diocesan Offices.** The second form of help he mentioned is prayer.

“Prayer is also very much needed so that we can show **our solidarity with our brothers and sisters who are suffering.**”

Denver, Colo., Oct 30, 2018 / 12:00 am (**CNA**).- As a caravan of thousands of migrants from Central America continues its trek north to the United States, the U.S. bishops' conference and leaders of Catholic aid agencies have urged government officials to treat migrants compassionately.

Signers of the joint statement, released on Monday, included **Bishop Joe Vásquez of Austin, chairman of the U.S. Bishop's committee on migration**, Sean Callahan, President and CEO of **Catholic Relief Services**, and Sr. Donna Markham OP, President and CEO of **Catholic Charities USA**.

Earlier this month, a group of about 160 migrants in Honduras started a migrant caravan, trekking northward to seek asylum as refugees in the United States. That caravan, which is now in Mexico, is believed to have peaked at 7,000 people, although several hundred have reportedly dropped off or fallen behind at various points.

Other smaller caravans have also started making their way north to the U.S., including a caravan of about 200 people from El Salvador.

The President of Mexico, Enrique Peña Nieto, has offered benefits such as temporary work permits and medical care to migrants who want to stay in the country, but at least 4,000 people are continuing the journey to the United States.

Catholic Churches along the route in Mexico have provided places of brief rest and refreshment, the Washington Post reported.

On Monday, U.S. President Donald Trump called the caravan "an invasion" and announced that 5,200 troops will be deployed to the U.S.-Mexico border by the end of the week to work with U.S. Customs and Border Protection to ensure enforcement of immigration laws.

The migrant caravan is still 900 miles from the United States, but is expected to reach the border in the next few weeks.

TAPACHULA, Mexico - Thousands of **Central American migrants** resumed an arduous trek toward the U.S. border Monday, with many bristling at suggestions there could be terrorists among them and saying the caravan is being used for political ends by U.S. President Donald Trump.

The caravan's numbers have continued to grow as they walk and hitch rides through hot and humid weather, and the United Nations estimated that it currently comprises some 7,200 people, "many of whom intend to continue the march north."

However, they were still at least 1,140 miles (1,830 kilometers) from the nearest border crossing - McAllen, Texas - and the length of their journey could more than double if they go to Tijuana-San Diego, the destination of another caravan earlier this year. That one shrank significantly as it moved through Mexico, and only a tiny fraction - about 200 of the 1,200 in the group - reached the California border.

MEXICO CITY - A caravan of Central American migrants traveling through Mexico was stopped after its push to the U.S. border set off a barrage of criticism from U.S. President Donald Trump.

The caravan of more than 1,000 migrants was winding its way through the Isthmus of Tehuantepec in southern Oaxaca state April 2 when the Mexican government announced it would move to break up the mass movement of people through the country.

In a joint statement, the interior and foreign relations ministries said the migrants - mostly from the violent and tumultuous northern triangle of Central America: Guatemala, Honduras and El Salvador - would be subject to "administrative procedures."

"What we have seen ... is when the caravan is followed in the media, the authorities keep their distance," said Alberto Xicotencatl, director of the diocesan migrant shelter in the northern city of Saltillo. "But when the march ends, there are repercussions against

the migrant and those that defend their rights."
