1. Moped Registration—H.3440 – Crosby– Crossed Over--Senate Transportation (1.28.15)
 - a. Requires that mopeds be registered, carry insurance, and be operated by an individual with a valid driver's license (currently a moped can be operated while a driver's license is suspended for a period of 6 months or less).
 - b. Requires moped operators and passengers to wear reflective vests.
 - c. Requires moped sellers to ensure certain features are on mopeds, including a rear red tail light that flashes continually while the moped is in motion.
 - d. Prohibits the operation of a moped on a public road that has a speed limit of greater than 55 mph and at a speed of more than 35 mph (currently 25 mph).
 - e. Requires mopeds to be operated in the far right lane while traveling along a multi-lane highway.
 - f. Requires moped dealers to provide explanations of the moped laws.
 - g. Increases moped operator license fee from \$2 to up to \$10.
 - h. Consolidates multiple different definitions of moped.
 - i. Passed the House (67-41)
 - j. **Concerns:** adds new regulations on businesses and individuals. Nanny-state bill.
