Dear Colleagues:

On Thursday, October 27, at 1:30 pm ET, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR), in partnership with the Department of State's Bureau of Population, Refugees, and Migration (PRM) and the Department of Homeland Security's United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS), will convene their next quarterly call on refugees issues with states, including representatives from the governors' offices and designated State Refugee Program officials.
