
Dear Mr. Keck:

He has paid more in indebtedness for his brother than the little piece of property in Langley, the Mill Village, could ever be worth. The problem is, his brother passed away in a nursing home.

I would appreciate it if you would look into this situation as soon as possible. Mr. Casnettie has all this material and can verify everything for your office.
