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**MINUTES**

**PRESENT:** REV. SAMUEL GREGORY- COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN, LEROY BLACKSHEAR- COMMITTEE MEMBER, ANDREW FULGHUM – ADMINISTRATOR, DALE TERRY- DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF ENGINEERING SERVICES, JUDITH FRANK – CLERK TO COUNCIL

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT THE ELECTRONIC AND PRINT MEDIA WERE NOTIFIED.

DURING PERIODS OF DISCUSSION AND/OR PRESENTATIONS MINUTES ARE TYPICALLY CONDENSED AND PARAPHRASED.

**CALL TO ORDER:** COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN GREGORY CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 3:00 P.M.

**INVOCATION:** COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN GREGORY GAVE THE INVOCATION.

**MONTHLY REPORTS:** MR. TERRY PRESENTED THE COMMITTEE WITH THE MONTHLY REPORTS. THERE WERE A TOTAL OF 51 ROADS WORKED, 1 DITCH WAS DUG, THE BACKHOE WORKED 3 DAYS AT THE HAPHAZARD LANDFILL, THERE WERE 63 BUILDING MAINTENANCE REQUESTS, A TOTAL OF 44 PIECES OF EQUIPMENT/CARS WERE WORKED ON AT THE CENTRAL GARAGE AND THERE WERE 10 REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE. MR. TERRY SAID THAT THERE WERE 22 LITTER CALLS WITH NO EVIDENCE, 1 WITH EVIDENCE AND THAT WAS CORRECTED AND 19 CITATIONS WERE ISSUED. MR. TERRY SAID THAT HE EXPECTED THE RECYLABLES AND SOLID WASTE RECIEPTS TO BE HIGHER NEXT MONTH. THE TOTAL FOR FEBRUARY WAS \$3,048.86. THE COMMITTEE DISCUSSED THE INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS ARRESTED FOR REMOVING A REFRIGERATOR FROM THE LANDFILL. MR. FULGHUM SAID HE DIRECTED THE INDIVIDUAL BACK TO THE JUDGE. MR. TERRY SAID THE INDIVIDUAL ELECTED TO PAY \$1,000.00 FINE AND NOT DO COMMUNITY SERVICE.

**ROADS AND DITCHES:** COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN GREGORY ASKED ABOUT THE ROADS AND MR. TERRY SAID THAT THE ROTATION IS ABOUT COMPLETE. COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN GREGORY ASKED IF THE EMPLOYEES STARTED WORKING ON THE DITCHES. MR. TERRY SAID THAT SOME

DITCHES IN THE PURRYSBURG AREA WERE WORKED LAST WEEK. MR. TERRY SAID HE WORKED SOME OF THE STATE DITCHES TO DRAIN THE COUNTY ROADS. MR. TERRY SAID WHEN THE STATE DITCHES ARE FULL, THE ROADS CANNOT DRAIN. COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN GREGORY ASKED WHY MALZONE RUSSELL'S CREWS ARE NOT WORKING THE DITCHES. MR. TERRY SAID THEY DID NOT HAVE THE EQUIPMENT TO DO IT. MR. TERRY SAID THEY DO HAVE A SPECIAL MACHINE FOR THE DITCHES, BUT IT HAS BEEN SITTING IN LEVY. MR. FULGHUM ASKED IF THE COUNTY COULD USE ANY OF THE STATE'S EQUIPMENT. MR. TERRY RESPONDED THAT HE NEVER ASKED, BUT HE DID NOT THINK THEY COULD. COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN GREGORY SAID THE STATE USED TO GET THINGS DONE. MR. TERRY SAID WHEN ALL THE WATER WAS ON THE ROADS, SCDOT WAS CLEANING THEIR EQUIPMENT BECAUSE THEY HAD AN INSPECTION SCHEDULED. MR. TERRY SAID HE ALWAYS DISCUSSES ANY WORK HE IS GOING TO DO ON STATE DITCHES WITH THE LOCAL SCDOT OFFICE.

**UPDATE ON PAVING COUNTY ROADS:** MR. TERRY PRESENTED AN ESTIMATE FROM DENNIS CORPORATION FOR PAVING 10 ROADS FOR ABOUT \$800,000.00. COMMITTEE MEMBER BLACKSHEAR REQUESTED THAT CHALMERS ROAD, PRINCE COURT, AND CAPTAINS WALK ROAD BE ADDED TO THE LIST AND TO ADJUST THE LIST TO ACCOMMODATE THEM. COMMITTEE MEMBER BLACKSHEAR SAID THERE WERE ROADS ON THE LIST THAT THE COMMITTEE DID NOT AGREE WITH. MR. FULGHUM SAID THE ESTIMATE IS FOR PAVING ONLY AND DOES NOT INCLUDE THE ENGINEERING SERVICES. IT WAS THE CONSENSUS OF THE COMMITTEE THAT IF THE COUNCIL APPROVED THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMITTEE THAT THE ADMINISTRATION AND MR. DENNIS SHOULD GO TO THE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE AND REQUEST \$400,000.00 TO START THE PAVING PROGRAM. MR. TERRY SAID HE WOULD MEASURE CHALMERS ROAD, PRINCE COURT AND CAPTAIN WALK ROAD AND PROVIDE THE MEASUREMENTS FOR MR. DENNIS TO GET AN ESTIMATE.

**ADJOURN:** COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN GREGORY ADJOURNED THE MEETING AT 4:00 P.M.
