Subject: SCDOT Update

Statewide Summary – The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) is continuing preparation activities for possible impacts anticipated by Hurricane Matthew. Current forecasts predict that Hurricane Matthew will begin with impacts in the lower coastal region beginning late today. SCDOT continues to closely monitor the forecast and adjust response plans as appropriate. At least 60 maintenance crews in the upstate and midlands are prepared to assist with road clearing in the coastal areas as soon as the initial assessment is performed in the storm's aftermath.
