WHEREAS, elected officials at each level of government, as well as business and citizens throughout our state are responsible for ensuring that all South Carolinians have access to clean, healthy drinking water; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of all South Carolinians to preserve our supply of clean drinking water for future generations.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 5 - 11, 2013, as

DRINKING WATER WEEK

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to work together to protect our state's natural water supply and other natural resources for the preservation of our environment for future generations.
