

October 5, 1944.

The State Budget Commission met in the Governor's Office at 11:00 o'clock A. M. on October 5, 1944. All members of the Commission were present.

Mr. T. E. Cumings, Superintendent of the Confederate Infirmary appeared before the Commission and requested an allotment from the Civil Contingent Fund of \$1,495.00 for the purpose of painting the Confederate Infirmary building. The Commission declined to grant this request on the grounds that the painting of these buildings should have been anticipated and request for funds made to the General Assembly.

The Commission discussed plans for holding departmental and institutional hearings on their 1945-46 budgets. It was agreed that these hearings should start shortly after November 7. The Secretary was instructed to arrange schedules and to invite Lieutenant-Governor Williams and Speaker of the House of Representatives Blatt to sit with the Commission on the hearings.

The Commission then adjourned.
