Dear Governor Haley:

The following request is authorized and made under the provisions of the South Carolina Freedom of Information Request Code of Law §30-4-10.

The purpose of this request is to respectfully ask you, or your delegate, to identify, locate and release to me certified public records including, but not limited to **1)** an act of the legislature of the State of South Carolina ceding the property on which the Clement F. Haynesworth Federal Building and United States Court House, located at 300 East Washington Street, Greenville, South Carolina, 29601, and the Charleston Federal Courthouse, located at 85 Broad Street, Charleston, South Carolina, 29401, to the United States federal government, or, in the alternative, **2)** the "NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE OF JURISDICTION" pursuant to Title 40, United States Code, Section 3112(b). **3)** I would also request the same records for any and all property claimed as owned, by cession, acceptance, or otherwise, throughout the state of South Carolina.

If it is learned that the above referenced properties, or any others of record, were NOT ceded by the Utah State Legislature, or that the "NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE OF JURISDICTION" pursuant to Title 40, United States Code, Section 3112(b) is NOT of record, I respectfully ask that you provide written certification of that fact with Official Seal and Signature for my records.

I ask for a waiver of all fees. However, if you cannot accommodate my request for a waiver, you are asked to contact my appointed Power of Attorney, Madeleine T. Ballou, at (843) 345-1079, whereupon provision will be made for payment.


