SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of the May 21, 1992; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving monthly reports as published by the Department of activities for the month of May, 1992.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$10,000.00 during the month of May 1992, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Clemson University to conduct an HPR study entitled "A Feasibility Study of the Use of Waste Materials in Highway Construction" at an estimated cost of \$49,908.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with the City of Landrum to extend its water system for the welcome center on I-26 in Spartanburg County at an estimated cost of \$170,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. VI with the LPA Group Inc., for Greenville and Laurens Counties from northeast of Road - 272 to east of I-26/S.C. 56 interchange at an estimated cost of \$545,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 2 with the Highway Users Federation in order to complete Phase B Services at an estimated cost of \$20,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into written agreements with Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for the purpose of statewide public transportation responsibility in accordance with the requirements FTA Sections 8, 16 (b), (2), 18, 26 (a) (2) and Rural Transit Assistance Program, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: On motion of Commissioner Self, seconded by Commissioner Drayton, the Commission passed a motion to adopt the 1992/93 Budget as presented with the following revisions and shown in detail in the Appendix. Commissioner Harrell cast a negative motion.

- (1) Fund Economic Development at \$25,000,000 as required by legislation
- (2) Fund State Institutions Program earmarked for the Citadel at \$227,000

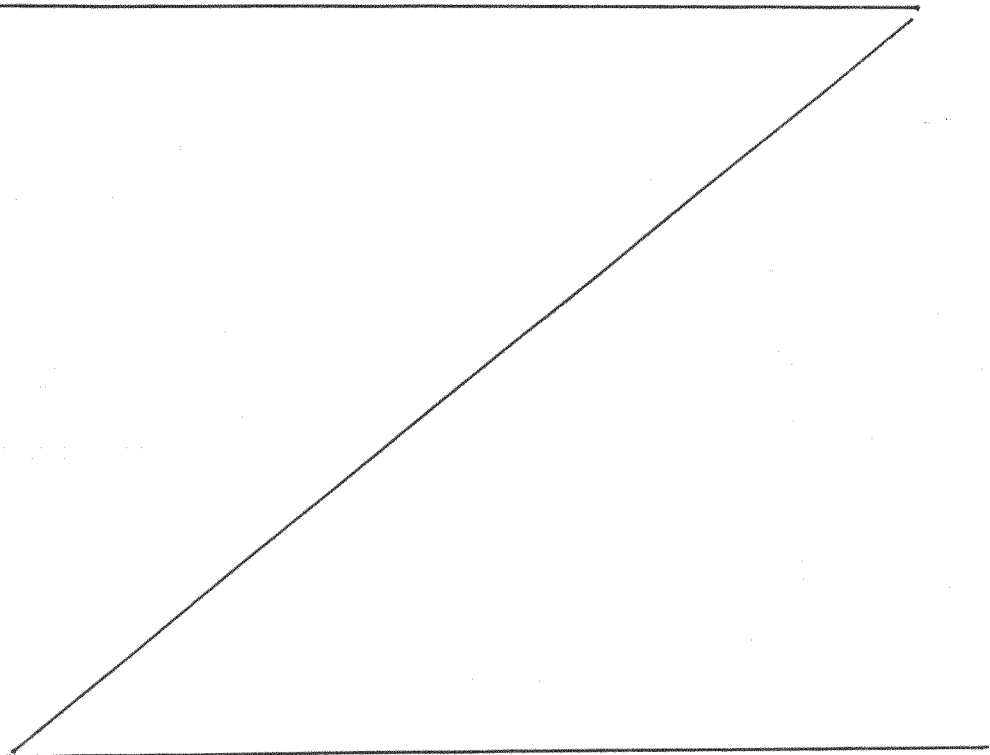
- (3) Amend the "C" Construction Program to distribute \$6,350,000 of the total apportionment for State Bridge Replacement Program, subject to legal opinion on the legality of this amendment.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion allocating \$49,445,000 to the State Highway Secondary or Farm-to-Market ("C") Program for fiscal year 1992/93, as follows:

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SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion allocating \$1,257,000.00 State Highway funds for the purchase of passenger vehicles, and allocating \$368,000.00 for trucks and trailers and \$340,000.00 for road machinery and equipment for the Central Administration vehicle pool, Engineering Field and vehicle pool, and further passed a motion allocating \$720,665.00 for the purchase of Computer Aided Drafting and Design (CADD) Equipment for the CADD Equipment Rental account, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: The Commission unanimously passed a motion concurring with Department's recommendation to approve the annual budget of State Public Transportation Funds for the fiscal year 1992-93, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing allocations, transfers and closures of accounts of State Highway funds for capital improvements/land and buildings, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: On motion of Commissioner Harvey, seconded by Commissioner Atkinson, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the blanket transfer from Ordinary Maintenance Allotments to Maintenance Resurfacing Allotments of estimated balances in each county.

SECTION 15: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department of right of way payments in the State Secondary "C" Construction Program for Aiken, Beaufort and Greenville Counties, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 16: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting the sale by the Department of surplus right of way property in Greenville County located at 1116 Staunton Bridge Rd. to Mr. S. Bruce Moore for \$1,010.00, for a one-story block house and for \$101.00 for a utility building, as shown in the Appendix.
