This past spring a 170 year-old hickory tree came down during a storm at Rose Hill Plantation. We have partnered with @Turned and Burned out of Woodruff, SC to create some "art" from this tree so that it may live on! These products are being sold exclusively in our Rose Hill park store. Interpretively, we refer to these old trees as "witness trees," because they have witnessed so much of this plantation's history. One of the oldest known hickory trees in the grove where that hickory came from dated to 1797 and others have dated to the 1810s. That makes this hickory a younger relative to them, but still a piece of history.
