I want to begin my letter by saying:

now to begin my letter, I was employed  
at Haylor Dining Facility at joint Base  
Charleston from 2/2012 to 2/2016.  
reasons for my leaving was because of  
unfair treatment and unfair practices  
on my job there that I could no longer  
tolerate. I have on occasions brought  
my concerns to HRD where my past  
supervisor advised our night shift  
employees to stop going to HRD. I have  
met with military in charge there  
Sgt. Greenwood, Sgt Mc Knight, but  
no change. I've left a message to  
1st Lt Commander's Office, no reply. so  
I was forced to resign under those



Conditions. I was on many occasions given more of a work load than others as you can see by the pictures of my work duty schedule I sent you. I was injured several times on the job and was refused light duty work that was available there but refused me. last in 12/01 of 2015 I had an Car accident on US-17 where I hit 2 doe deer. after returning to work I was refused using my sick leave by My Supp.

Mrs. I Deas Ferguson. on Jan 23, 2016 I come into work, after reaching the night duty schedule I was assigned Kitchen duty only which is not often I get to be assigned only one duty. I began my duty for the night. 10 min before my break at 10pm Mrs Ferguson came to me after pilling many pots and pans on a rack in the pots and pans area and told me to start washing some of my pots and pans because she knew I like my area clean before my break, I replied! I am not assigned pots and pans but Troy another employee does she replied



no! I changed the schedule and you have the kitchen and pots and pans. I asked her why haven't she told me until now and she smiled and said; Oh I forgot. I did wash the pots and pans leaving me with only 8 min. of a breacktime. I was very upset that night because I felt that this was another one of her games she play to get employees upset to refuse a duty giving her the opportunity to write them up as she so often do. later that night she came to me and said Ms. Jones I changed the schedule, you will help Troy clean the clipper. (The dishwasher) now not only did she assigned me his work area, but now work my area and help him clean his. I avoided her that night to refrain myself from saying things I did not want to say. I was denied my unemployment Benefits, I appealed bringing with me proof of schedules pictures showing where I was assigned on many occasions



more of a work duty than other.  
2 pictures of a large amount of  
french fries that my super. Idas  
Ferguson swept under some kettles  
in a area in the kitchen I have  
already cleaned for me to do extra  
work behind her. I have presented  
these pictures to SMSGT Debra Morely  
Sgt. McKnight and my supervisors Boss  
Mrs. Patricia Butler. As I have said  
I called and left a message to  
IG Commander. no response. I was  
forced to resign because I could  
no longer work under those conditions  
there at Gaylor Dining on joint Base  
Charleston. I recently work across  
the street at Vehicle Opps 843-963-4236  
I have recieved a Commander Token  
for excellent work at Vehicle Opps.  
I am fed up with the retaliation games  
the civilian supervisors played  
when I confronted them with my  
concerns. speaking out on situations  
(ex) how a shift leader yelled at  
our active duty Military and caught



the ~~problem~~ I've faced while  
employed at Dayton Dining on  
your Base Club. I feel obliged to  
be addressed. Several employees  
have since left and quit after I  
did. and nothing has been done.  
our active duty Military should  
have a pleasant place to sit  
and enjoy a good meal without  
seeing and experiencing yelling and  
fighting which happened on 1st + 2nd  
shifts. I am presently serving for a  
Mother who has nursing ~~shift~~ + demonstrating  
and ~~have~~ have a message to provide  
shelter for her. my picture of  
yourself as I mention in it  
happened. If Base in TX with  
letter of other employees who experienced  
the same as I did. Please look  
into me and my unemployment claim.  
Thank you so much.
