lot in the 205 acre, lying E. of the C of C, in
which is known as the Liberty Hill Section to
any bonds or followers, to wit; in by
lands of the Est. of Boston Parker, & by lands
of Eli Thompson, S by lands of William White
& W. by Washington St. & Libby Hill ally. This
being the same land bought by my mother
from Boston Parker, except two lots which
my mother, Rosa Perkins, sold off to Eli
Thompson and Elizabeth Sims. This lot is a
rectangle in shape being about the same number
of feet in its N & S sides, but being much
narrower on its E. side than on its W. side.

at the time of her death and all of her
funeral expenses and expenses of her
last illness having been taken care of by
her insurance policy and it is being distributed
