SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, August 26-27, 1985

REPORT OF CONSULTANTS

Undergraduate and graduate degree programs in Visual and Performing Arts were evaluated by a team of out-of-State consultants in December 1984. The Commission approved a report based on the recommendations of the consultants.

REPORT ON TWO-YEAR INSTITUTIONS

The Commission approved a report on cooperation between two-year institutions in Beaufort and Sumter, and a recommendation that a professional study of the library needs of the two-year institutions in Sumter be presented to the Commission by April 1986.

CONTINUING DESEGREGATION ORTS

The Commission endorsed the concept of a State plan for continuing desegregation efforts in 1986 and beyond. The final draft of the State-initiated plan will be presented to the Commission in December 1985.

PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS

The Commission approved the following permanent improvement requests: (1) two leases from Coastal Carolina Educational Foundation, USC-Coastal Carolina; (2) signage request, Medical University of South Carolina; and (3) construction of early child care facility, Aiken Technical College.

BUDGET OF CHARLESTON HIGHER EDUCATION CONSORTIUM

The Commission approved the 1985-86 budget of the Charleston Consortium in the amount of \$224,378.

1986-87 APPROPRIATION REQUESTS

The presidents of the public colleges and universities and the executive director of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education presented their 1986-87 appropriation requests to the Commission.
