**11 a.m. UPDATE: "Dusk to Dawn" curfew to be enforced;
Residents have less than an hour to get off of Tybee Island**

Chatham County and City of Savannah officials urge residents not to be lulled into complacency about the approaching Hurricane Matthew, possibly influenced by television reports of what is currently occurring in Florida as the storm 'skirts' the Florida coast.

Based on the latest information from NOAA (see map), Chatham County will possibly experience hurricane force winds on land, with major storm surge expected.
