The Hunting Island State Park staff was instrumental in a rescue & release of a leatherback sea turtle this weekend, when the turtle stranded itself because it was tangled in a rope and a crab trap. The staff, along with South Carolina Department of Natural Resources, hydrated and restrained the turtle until veterinarians from the South Carolina Aquarium could arrive and assess the injuries. After medical care, the turtle was released. A cool fact -- this turtle had been originally tagged in Trinidad and made it's way to the South Carolina coast!
