Re: Service on the Uniform Law Commission and elsewhere

Dear Nikki:

I write about two matters.

Uniform Law Commission

First, I would respectfully request to be re-appointed to continue my service to South Carolina on the Board of Commissioners for the Promotion of Uniformity of Legislation in the United States, commonly referred to as the Uniform Law Commission. (I assume that I need to be re-appointed, as my term expires with yours.) In my two years on the Commission I have become actively involved in two projects, in addition to the general service to the commission as a whole. Both projects are ongoing, and I would like the opportunity to complete them. I have also worked well with Ed Mullins, who has led our delegation during my service on it.

The Commission is studying an act to address the use of autonomous (driverless) vehicles. This is a very hot topic, and we are on the cutting edge of the law. Let me add that given the growing role of the automotive industry in this state, this issue is of particular interest to me. I am an active member of the committee studying this issue, and this effort should continue until at least 2017. I very much want to see this project through to completion.

I have also served on a committee that has re-written the uniform act governing transfers of property to defraud creditors. This two year effort was completed in July of this year. Shortly after that I, along with the chairman of that committee and one other lawyer, was asked to serve on the enactment committee to pursue the nationwide effort to get the act passed by all states. This effort is just beginning and will take years. I would welcome the opportunity to pursue this as well.

We have a small delegation in comparison to many other states, but our profile is now growing within this national organization.

Other Service

I understand that my service on the ULC does not disqualify me from serving on any state board or commission. If you determine that I can serve the state in some other way I would be grateful for the opportunity do so.
