Thank you for your patience with me! We look forward to hosting Lt. Governor Bryant with us on June 4. We do have 2 services at 9:15am and 10:45am. We are a more casual atmosphere than most established churches. I typically wear a buttoned up collared shirt and khakis.

In the attached form, I requested some talking points. If I could get a brief description of the scenario Lt. Governor Bryant will be referencing in our talk, I'd really appreciate it. I will also ask some follow-up questions, as they arise during the interview. I will be preaching that morning about how to walk through times of depression and disappointment, using the story of Elijah from 1 Kings 17-19. By no means am I expecting a "depression" talk from the Lt. Governor! I would like for him to share how the Lord helped him through a time of adversity in his life. We are featuring the stories of individuals in this format each Sunday. So far, we have touched on a mother losing her son, going through divorce, and facing cancer treatments in our testimonies. Again, it would be helpful to know the nature of the time of adversity the Lt. Governor wants to address.

I need for Lt. Governor Bryant to be at our church ready to go by 9am that day, so I can get his microphone situated, etc. We will do this interview twice that morning, once in each service. The time of his interview will be right before I preach. If he needs to slip away after his second interview in the 10:45am service we understand. Of course, we would love to have him as long as he can stay. I know our people would welcome the opportunity to meet him. Please let me know if you have any questions!
