## **PROBLEM GAMBLING** **FACTS / STATISTICS**

- Approximately 6 million adults and 500,000 teens meet criteria for gambling addiction.
- The estimated annual societal cost of gambling-related addiction, bankruptcy, and crime in America is \$7 billion dollars.
- 75% of US adults have gambled at least once in the last year, 15% at least weekly.
