

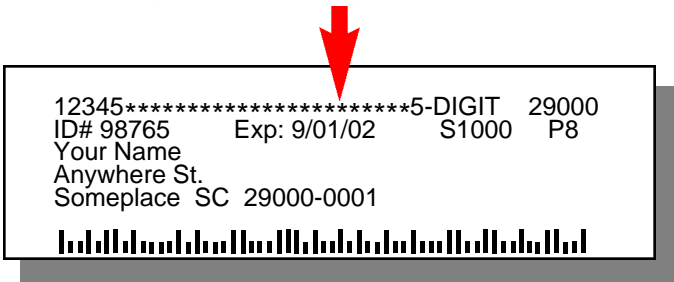
Market Bulletin Renewal Process Started

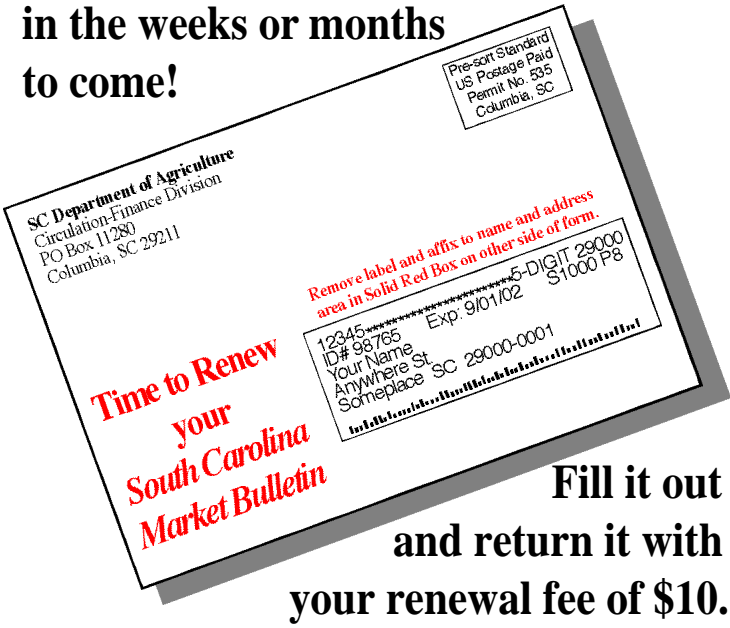

Summer of 2002---time to renew

The 4th of July is a special celebration---the anniversary of the day on which the Declaration of Independence was adopted by the Continental Congress, July 4, 1776. Particularly on this day, we "renew" our allegiance to our state and nation by proudly waving Old Glory.

Now is also the time of the year that we "renew" our subscriptions to the *Market Bulletin*. In the summer of 1913, the *Market Bulletin* was established. Thanks to you, the subscribers to the *Market Bulletin*, we are able to continue to provide this publication which has been a valuable resource for all South Carolinians---farmers and non-farmers.

Last summer, because of budget cuts, we began charging for subscriptions to the *Market Bulletin*, and, once again, it's time to begin accepting renewals for the upcoming year.

Your renewal date is based on the expiration date on your label. For instance, if "Exp: 9/01/02" is on your label, you must renew your subscription by September 1, 2002. If "Exp: 10/01/02" is on your label, you must renew your subscription by October 1, 2002, etc. You should receive a post card in the mail requesting you to renew your subscription 6 to 8 weeks before your expiration date. The renewal schedule is listed for your review. Some of you whose expiration date is in September may have already received your renewal post card. A sample of the post card is also provided on this page. Whenever you receive your post card, please follow these directions:

- Detach the renewal coupon from the post card by cutting along the dotted line.
- Peel the label from the front and apply it in the designated area.
- If you have any changes in your address, write those changes in the box provided.
- Send the completed coupon with your check or money order for \$10 in an envelope to:

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Columbia, SC 29211

Please do not write in the gray area designated for **OFFICE USE ONLY**. Allow 6 to 8 weeks for the processing of your subscription, and please **DO NOT INCLUDE ADS IN THE ENVELOPE WITH YOUR SUBSCRIPTION COUPON AND FEE**. Renewals are processed elsewhere, and ads included with the renewal coupon could very well get lost in the shuffle. Multiple year subscriptions and fees will not be accepted, and there will be no refunds.

On behalf of all involved in the state's agriculture, thank you for your continued support through your subscription to the *Market Bulletin*. I ask you to take time right now to look at your label at the top left-hand corner of this page to see when your subscription expires. Then, when you receive your post card in the mail, make sure to renew your subscription for another year.

So, while renewing your allegiance to the flag by waving the red, white, and blue this 4th of July, I invite you to join us in celebrating the 89th anniversary of the *Market Bulletin* by renewing your subscription. You could make a significant difference in the continuation of this long-standing icon of agriculture in South Carolina. And, by buying and selling agricultural products through the *Market Bulletin*, you could also make a difference for yourself!

Tobacco Tour

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The tour which will begin at the tobacco facility in the rear of the Pee Dee REC, located off I-95 at TV Road (Exit 169), will include agronomic, disease, and insect tests, several of which show excellent results. Disease stops will include Granville wilt, TSWV (Tomato Spotted Wilt Virus), and nematodes. Agronomic stops will include sucker control, RSP and OVT Variety Tests, and herbicide and fertility tests. In addition to the tests at the Pee Dee REC, participants will tour a Regional Variety Farm Test, and on Wednesday, will visit on-farm tests ending the tour near Dillon at approximately 5:00 p.m.

Dr. Dewitt T. Gooden, Extension Agronomist, says, "At this point, the tobacco crop is on schedule; and we anticipate a good crop. Currently, most tobacco is between lay-by and contacts. We are experiencing a significant problem with TSWV. We will visit one on-farm test that illustrates the current best management of TSWV."

TSWV is a plant virus so named because tomatoes were the first plants on which it was found. Diagnosis is often misleading, if based on symptoms alone. Thrips are common transport vehicles for the viruses. TSWV first was discovered on tomatoes in 1919 and now is known to infect over 300 different hosts including tobacco.

Registration at the door will begin at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 9th. The tour is scheduled to end at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 10th. Dinner is scheduled for Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. at the Pee Dee REC.
