Description/Significant Features: Road 1306.04 is an unnamed road that extends 0.98 mile southeast through the central portion of the project tract. Road 1306.04 begins at its intersection with Line Road before ending at Road 1306.03. Road 1306.04 intersects one other historic road (1306.07) and one non-historic road (B). Road 1306.04 is a dirt road that averages 15 ft wide and 25-37 ft amsl elevation. Most of the roadbed lies at ground level except where it crosses through wetlands, where it is raised two to three ft above ground surface.

Historical Information

Historical Information: In addition to Line Road (Road 1306), Roads 1306.01-1306.04 comprise the remainder of the five roads on the project tract attributed to the plantation era (ca. 1675-1865).

Historic aerials and quadrangles show Road 1306.04 (USGS 1920, 1944, 1957, 1959, 1961, 1973). During the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries, this road connected Wampee Plantation with Wragg's Middle and Savannah Plantations. Into the mid-twentieth century, the road continued south into neighboring Middleton Plantation (USGS 1920, 1957).
