Hi Dorothy,  
In consultations with LIRS, Lutheran Services Carolinas would like to increase proposed number of new refugee arrivals in South Carolina.

As proposed last year, we will continue to work on opening sub-office in Charleston that would serve 75 – 100 refugees in FY2017. Our Columbia office would serve 200 refugees. The total increase is 80 from current 220 approved for FY16.

Please note that the increase does not include refugees from Syria.

Please let me know if you are in agreement with the proposed 300 refugee arrivals in FY2016-2017.
