Senator,

This is what I was able to find out:

With the addition of the new 7th district, the composition of the DNR Board was updated to consist of 7 total members, one per district. Mr. Lowe, who served in the 5th district seat prior to redistricting, was redrawn into the new 7th district seat. Because Mr. Lowe's term does not expire until 7/1/14, he will continue his term until that date as the 7th district board member. As no member of the board was redrawn into the 5th district and no new appointment has been made, the seat is currently vacant.
