Agenda Items

1. **Ethics** – H.3945 – House Judiciary's Constitutional Law Subcommittee will take up Ethics Reform today upon adjournment of the House
2. **Certificate of Need (CON)** – Hearing in Senate Medical Affairs subcommittee on May 7.
3. **DSS Transparency**– H.5015 – May come up in the House today, but it is not on the calendar.
4. **John De La Howe** – H.4920 – Passed the House and referred to the Senate Education Committee on 3/25/2014.

Yesterday's Floor Action

Senate

1. **Transportation** – H. 3412 – Rep Harell's transportation bill was placed on Special Order on 4/30 at 4:00 PM. Roll call vote required: 34-4. Sen. Cleary spoke on the motion and guaranteed there will be no increase in fees or taxes.
2. **Election Bill** – H.3198 – Senators Peeler, Campsen and Scott were appointed as conferees.

House

1. **Election Bill** – H.3198 – Reps. Clemmons, J.E. Smith, and Ballentine were appointed as conferees.

Committee Hearings:

1. **Senate Finance** – The Senate Finance Committee passed the budget largely intact last night. The plan is to put the budget on the floor of the Senate next week.
