Subject: Budget Punchlist

As I look back over v73, here are some of the questions that are still open:

- How has the Department of Education justified the \$1,188,000 tab for Virtual Schools (#1302) when the fiscal impact was supposedly zero a few months ago? Why the discrepancy?
- What's the General Fund impact for a tuition grant cap of \$2,950, vs. the \$3,000 requested in #694?
- When will PRT get us their NR list?
- Do we have some good numbers to put in front of her on annual revenues for and funds currently available to the Rural Infrastructure Authority?
- We need the Attorney General's Office to give us the chop on #1059 for doing 4 prosecutors vs. 6 prosecutors and a coordinator.
- PPP has to get us something on projected supervision ratio changes in FY 2014-15.
- In #774, Human Affairs cites lease, parking, and energy costs as their need for a \$25k bump in operating costs. I thought the point of the move was that it was going to be cheaper now. We need BCB's side of the story on this one.
- Les' folks have to post Adjutant General still.

I'd like to get these closed out today/tomorrow.
