Mr. Dwight Mehaffy, Mr. Bill Strader and Mr. Bob Promburer from Piedmont Olsen, Inc. appeared before Council with their solution to the septage problem in Anderson County. They began by explaining what septage waste was and it's characteristics. He said that it was highly variable and very concentrated; therefore the handling of the waste was very important. They discussed possible alternatives to the septage disposal problem. (Six & Twenty WTP, tie in with City, or tap on to city trunk lines) In designing for a septage treatment center, a basic receiving station is the first thing needed. They recommended that the County have control over what is dumped into the system; a threat of random sampling would be advised. Piedmont Olsen suggested that Council consider revamping the Six and Twenty Plant. Council discussed. The plant in Pickens County and Joanna was discussed. Council considered building a waste treatment center near the Anderson Airport where the waste would be treated and then dumped into Rocky River WTP. The steps to building the center and cost was discussed. Chairman Holden asked that the item be on the next agenda for Council's consideration.

Council adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
