- The personal information must be submitted accurately and match exactly what's on the ID that you present to the Secret Service for entry.
- Children under the age of 18 do not need to bring IDs with them to the White House.

Guests should plan to arrive through the **East Gate, which is located at 15th Street NW and Hamilton Place NW (just south of the Treasury Building)**. We recommend that guests arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the tour start time in order to have time to pass through security.
